The Rise of Technology

Before the invention of computers, almost every job and task had to be carried out by people. However, the recent advances in technology and A.I. means that these have been playing an increasingly significant role in replacing humans in the workplace. It seemed as if people had been working in jobs that could have easily been done by machines and it only took the invention of more sophisticated computer programmes to cause their jobs to change. Therefore, I decided to investigate the subject further to discover if this theory might be true. I spoke to Abdulla, the manager of a clothing factory, which had recently replaced many of its staff members with goods-packaging machines.

“Before we purchased the packaging machines,” he explained, “it took the staff almost a day to prepare one shipment. Whereas now, using the machines, the work will have been completed in a third of the time. It goes without saying that this is a huge benefit for the company because, as well as making the processes faster, using the state-of-the-art technology raises interest in our brand, which in turn increases profits while lowering staffing costs. So, no matter how it affects the people who work here, I’m keen on introducing more technology into the factory.”

Some people, though, are not as enthusiastic. I spoke to Alia, who’s on the point of losing her job working as a receptionist. She says that soon, her role will have been replaced by an A.I.-powered robot and so I asked her how she felt about it.

“When I heard about it I was sad,” she replied. “Even in roles where people prefer to speak directly to one another, it appeared as though the requirement for humans had been reduced by the rise of technology. I suppose if I’d studied computing at university, I’d probably have a job working in a more technical field now. In fact, I’m planning to change my career so I’m on the point of retraining as a computer engineer. Even though I don’t agree with the thought of introducing more technology in workplaces, it should allow me to get ahead with my career.”

“I predict that the technical advances will continue and no matter how anxious it makes people, the use of technology in the workplace won’t stop increasing,” she replied.
