



Falconry: An Ancient Sport

Falconry is the practice of training and using birds of prey, such as falcons and hawks, to hunt small animals. This sport is very old; people have practiced falconry for over 4,000 years! It is thought to have started in the Middle East and Central Asia and then spread to Europe, North Africa, and even Japan.

In falconry, a trained bird wears a small leather hood over its head to keep it calm. The falconer, the person who trains the bird, uses a glove to protect their hand and a special rope called a "leash" to control the bird. When the bird is ready to hunt, the falconer removes the hood. The bird flies into the sky and searches for small animals, like rabbits or mice. When the bird catches an animal, it brings it back to the falconer.

Falconry requires a lot of patience and skill. It can take years to train a bird properly, and the falconer must develop a close bond with the bird. Many people who practice falconry say it is not just a sport but also a way of life.

Research shows that for most people, the least favorite part of shopping is waiting to pay for their items. When shops started using contactless payment, they saw a 30% increase in sales. People were spending more money, and this was good for business.

5. Online banking is another new way we can use smartphones to make our finances more convenient. One advantage is that a person can send money quickly and easily from their own bank account into another bank account using there smart phone. Unlike banks, online banking doesn't close in the afternoon and you can use it anywhere. This is very useful, especially if any of your family members are abroad and need money quickly.

6. There are worries about how safe online banking and contactless payment is. However, remember most companies have safety features in their apps. If you are worried, here are three suggestions. Firstly, make sure you always have a lock on your phone. Secondly, never share bank details with anyone you don't know and, thirdly, try not to make your numbers really simple or something like your birthday date.
