




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FUTURE PERFECT PASSIVE

A SIMPLE AND DETAILED EXPLANATION

The Future Perfect Passive tense :

is used to talk about an action that will be completed at some point in the future, but we focus on the object of the action rather than the person or thing performing it. This is useful when the doer of the action is unknown, unimportant, or obvious.

Structure of Future Perfect Passive

To form the Future Perfect Passive, we use the following structure:

➤ **Active Voice:**

☞ Subject + will have + past participle + object

✅ She will have finished the report by tomorrow.

➤ **Passive Voice:**

☞ Object + will have been + past participle (+ by + agent, if necessary)

✅ The report will have been finished by tomorrow.

➤ **Breakdown of the Passive Structure:**

Object → The thing receiving the action.

Will have been → The future perfect auxiliary verbs.

Past participle → The third form of the verb (e.g., written, completed, built).

(By + agent) → The doer of the action (optional).

When Do We Use the Future Perfect Passive?

- When the focus is on the result of an action in the future, not who does it.

By next week, the project will have been completed.

(We care about the completion, not who did it.)

- When the doer is unknown or not important.

A new law will have been passed by next year.

(We don't need to say who passed it.)

- In formal or academic writing.

By the end of the year, many new discoveries will have been made.

Examples: Active vs. Passive

Active Sentence	Passive Sentence
The workers will have finished the building by next month.	The building will have been finished by next month.
Scientists will have discovered a new planet.	A new planet will have been discovered.
They will have announced the results by 5 PM.	The results will have been announced by 5 PM.
The chef will have prepared dinner before 8 PM.	Dinner will have been prepared before 8 PM.
