6. Parts of Speech

- There are eight **parts of speech** in English.
- The **parts of speech** tell us how a word is used in a sentence.

Example Sentences:

My little sister and I walk slowly to the beach.

His black cat jumped quickly over the wall because it saw a bird.

Part of Speech	How the Word is Used	Examples
noun	names a person, place or thing	king, Ahmed, road, Dubai, sleep, pencil
pronoun	takes the place of a noun	she, he, it, you, we, they
adjective	describes a noun	new, hungry, difficult, delicious, fast, happy
verb	names an action or state of being	run, fly, is, was, shine, jump, climb
adverb	describes a verb or adjective	slowly, daily, far, badly, usually, always
conjunction	joins words together	and, but, because, for, as, if, or
preposition	connects a noun to the rest of the sentence	on, near, at, in, up, into
article	used before a noun	a, an, the



