Irregular Verbs

- To talk about what happened yesterday, we use the **PAST TENSE**.
- Irregular Verbs **CHANGE** completely example:

Go -> Went

Eat -> Ate

Do -> Did



go --> went



eat --> ate



do --> did

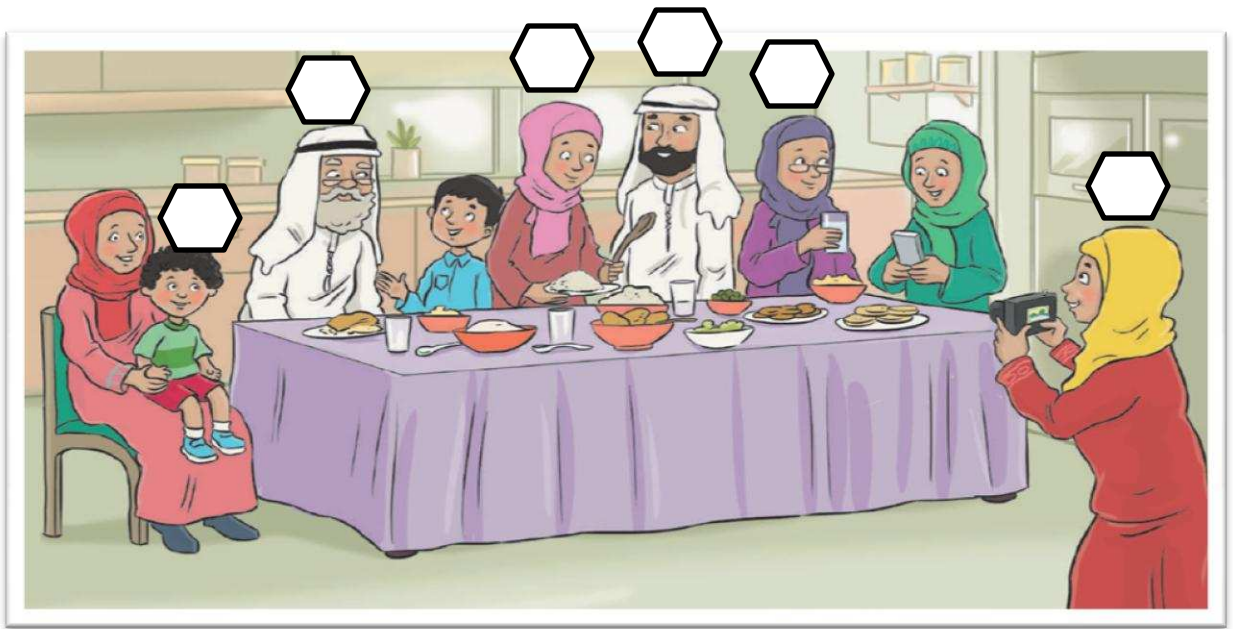
Remember :

An **Irregular Verb** is one that does not take the ending for the Past Simple form.

While most Irregular Verbs **change completely** (ex: buy --> bought)

Some irregular verbs **do not change** (ex: put --> put)

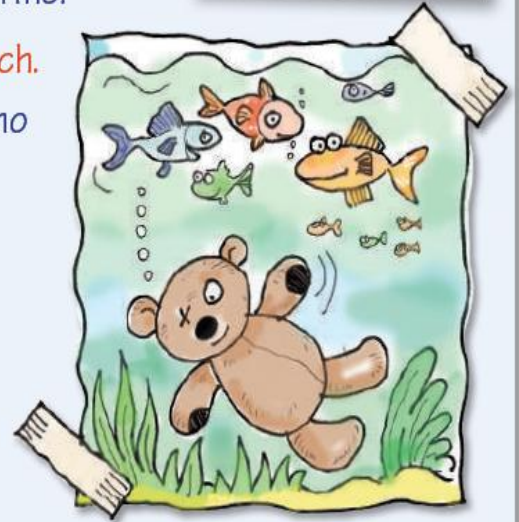
A sad memory
