Do you like shopping? Yes, I do. Do you enjoy watching TV? No, I don't.	
Meaning	A yes/no question is a question whose expected answer is one of two choices either <b>yes</b> or <b>no</b> .
Grammatical structure	<u>Questions (yes/no questions)</u>
Usage	Yes/No questions need either a <b>yes</b> or a <b>no</b> as the answer. They are used to seek confirmation or denial of a situation, fact, or opinion.
Other examples	Did you travel in the summer? No, I didn't. Do you have a pet? Yes, I do.

I like this book. $\rightarrow$ I like <u>it</u> . My mother is giving the children toys. $\rightarrow$ My mother is giving <u>them</u> toys. He saw the girl on the street. $\rightarrow$ He saw <u>her</u> on the street.	
Meaning	Object pronouns are pronouns that receive the action in a sentence. They are <b>me</b> , <b>you</b> , <b>him</b> , <b>her</b> , <b>us</b> , <b>them</b> , and <b>whom</b> .
Grammatical structure	Pronouns: object pronouns
Usage	Used in place of a proper noun or a noun to describe who or what is acted upon by the subject of the sentence.
Other examples	Can you ask Ahmed? $\rightarrow$ Can you ask <u>him</u> ? My brother is doing homework. $\rightarrow$ My brother is doing <u>it</u> . I know Aisha. $\rightarrow$ I know <u>her</u> . I will call my mother and father. $\rightarrow$ I will call <u>them</u> .

<u>Where</u> is the book? The book is under the chair. <u>What</u> is your name? My name is Aisha. <u>Who</u> is your teacher? My teacher is Mr. Jones.

Meaning	To find out when/where/why/who/what/how information about something or someone
Grammatical structure	Questions (wh-questions)
Usage	What – for things Where – for places Who – for people Why – for reasons When – for time
Other examples	<u>When</u> do you finish your exam? <u>Who</u> is going to the wedding? <u>Why</u> didn't you finish your meal?

I <u>asked</u> my friend to go on a trip with me. They <u>went</u> home after their mountain holiday. My grandparents <u>were</u> late collecting me.

Meaning	You can state things that happened and finished in the past.
Grammatical structure	Past Time (past simple (including verb 'to be')
Usage	We can use the simple past to talk about actions that happened. We can use it when talking about things that were true.
Other examples	He <u>rode</u> his bike to school. The museum <u>was</u> closed yesterday. My family <u>watched</u> a movie.

#### What <u>are you doing</u>? I <u>am feeding</u> the cat. I <u>feed</u> it at 4pm every day.

Meaning	I am feeding = doing it now; I feed = same time every day The person gives the cat food now and gives the cat food at the same time every day.
Grammatical str ucture	<u>Present continuous</u> (to express present time) <u>Present continuous</u> subject + to be + verb (ing) + object <u>Present simple</u> subject + verb + object
Usage	We use present simple to talk about things we do regularly (I play basketball every Sunday). We use the present continuous (verb + ing) to talk about things we are doing now at the time of speaking (I'm playing hockey now).
Other examples	The lion <u>is sleeping</u> now. He <u>sleeps</u> in the afternoon. They <u>are watching</u> the animals. He <u>isn't reading</u> , he' <u>s playing</u> with the dog.




