We use adjectives with present simple to describe a person, place or thing. They provide more information about qualities such as size, colour, age, shape, emotion, etc. In a present simple sentence, adjectives come after the main verb, 'to be'.

# His bike is <u>red</u>.

My feet are <u>small</u>. The building is <u>tall</u>.

# Sabeel walked to school.

Amna did not play tennis after school.


