Endangered Animals

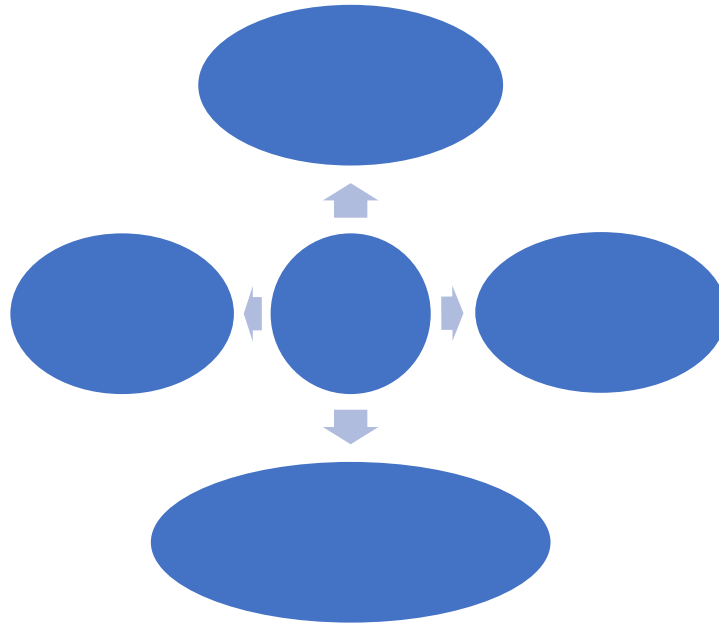
