





When we asked about free time spent indoors, 30% of people we asked like reading. Nearly 10% of young people like writing poetry and 20% like writing stories. The other 30% of people like




1. The Greatest Ship Ever Built. The Titanic was launched in 1912 and was the largest ship in the ocean. In April 1912, it left England, United Kingdom for New York on its maiden voyage. Passengers called it the unsinkable ship because people said it could not sink.

2. The Headlines On the night of Sunday 14th April, four days after the ship left England, the passengers heard a loud crash. The Titanic hit a large white object, it was an iceberg. Soon, the ship began to sink. It took three hours for the ship to sink after hitting the iceberg. It sank to the bottom of the North Atlantic Ocean.

3. Arriving in New York The Titanic had more than 2000 passengers on board when it left England. Less than 700 people got on the lifeboats. There were not enough lifeboats for everyone to escape. More than 1500 died.

4. Exploring the Shipwreck On Tuesday. April 16th, the newspapers said, Titanic sunk, no lives lost. They didn't know what had happened. Later it was changed to Titanic sunk, A terrible disaster. The wreck of the ship was found in 1985. Scientists found objects such as silver, letters, clothes, shoes and other personal belongings. Sporting Heroes

LeBron Raymone James is an American professional basketball player in the National Basketball Association (NBA). He was introduced to basketball at the age of nine. Top qualities such as, co-ordination and competitiveness are needed in order to be a good basketball player. Together with determination and agility they have made Lebron James one of the greatest basketball players. Athletes of the NBA said, "He is going to be the best basketball player on Earth". His coach agreed. "I definitely agree! He is going to be a very successful athlete", he said.

James also agreed. He said, 'I knew I was going to be a successful champion. It has been my dream since I was a little boy'.

Top qualities such as quick reactions and competitiveness have made Usain Bolt one of the greatest Olympic athletes of all time, but it was his speed that gave him the name "Lightning Bolt". Bolt loved sports as a child. He played football and cricket. "As a child I knew I was going to be a successful athlete", he said. In 2007, Bolt became an Olympic champion when he won the 100m sprint. In the 2008 Beijing Summer Olympics, he won first place in 3 races.
