- **Recently** : not long ago .
- **White-water rafting** : a sport done on a fast-moving river .
- **Operation** : a process in which a doctor cuts into a patient's body .
- **Wheel chair** : transport for someone who can't walk .

verb + infinitive with to

After some verbs we use an infinitive with to:

(**agree, begin, continue, decide, forget, hope, learn, remember, start, try**)

The students *learn to study* online.

verbs (+ object) + infinitive with to

After the following verbs you can put an object between the verb and the infinitive:

(**ask, choose, expect, help, like, prefer, promise, want**)

They *want to learn* independently.

They *want you to learn* independently.

After the following verbs you must use an object between the verb and the infinitive with to:

(**allow, encourage, invite, teach, tell**)

- **Other verbs are followed by the -ing form of the verb.**

- (**begin, continue, start and prefer**)

Ex :- *I prefer learning individually.*
