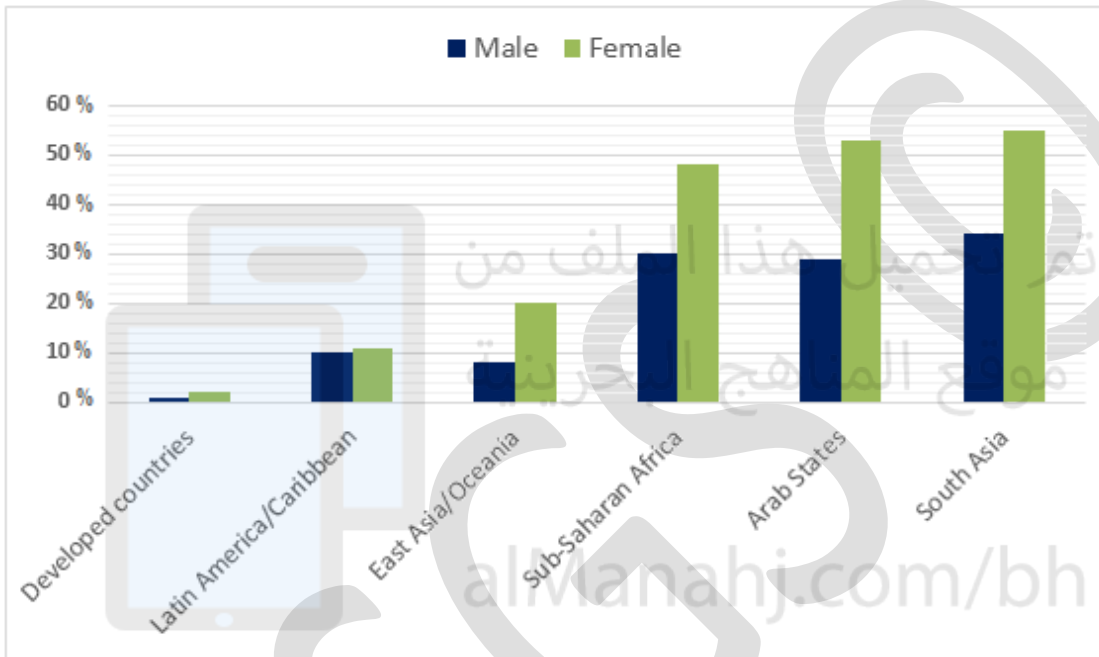

The bar chart compares the illiteracy rates between both (1) _____ in six regions of the world in (2) _____. A quick look at the diagram shows that the illiteracy rate among (3) _____ was higher than (4) _____ and the percentages of uneducated people in South Asia, Arab states and Sub-Saharan Africa parts were greatly higher than other parts of the world.

Men and women, unable to read or write, made up only (5) ____% and 2% in developed countries. Whilst, the number of illiterate citizens in Latin America and the Caribbean were higher, 10% and (6) ____%. In (7) _____, however, the gap was enormous; there were 20% illiterate females compared to 8% males.

In summary, the South Asian, Arabian and Sub-Saharan countries had a severe illiteracy rate compared to any part of the world and female illiteracy rate was higher than the male illiteracy rate all over the world.

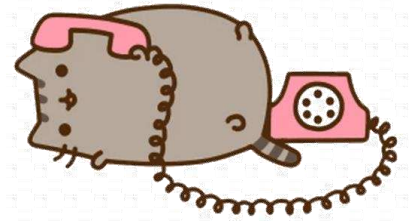

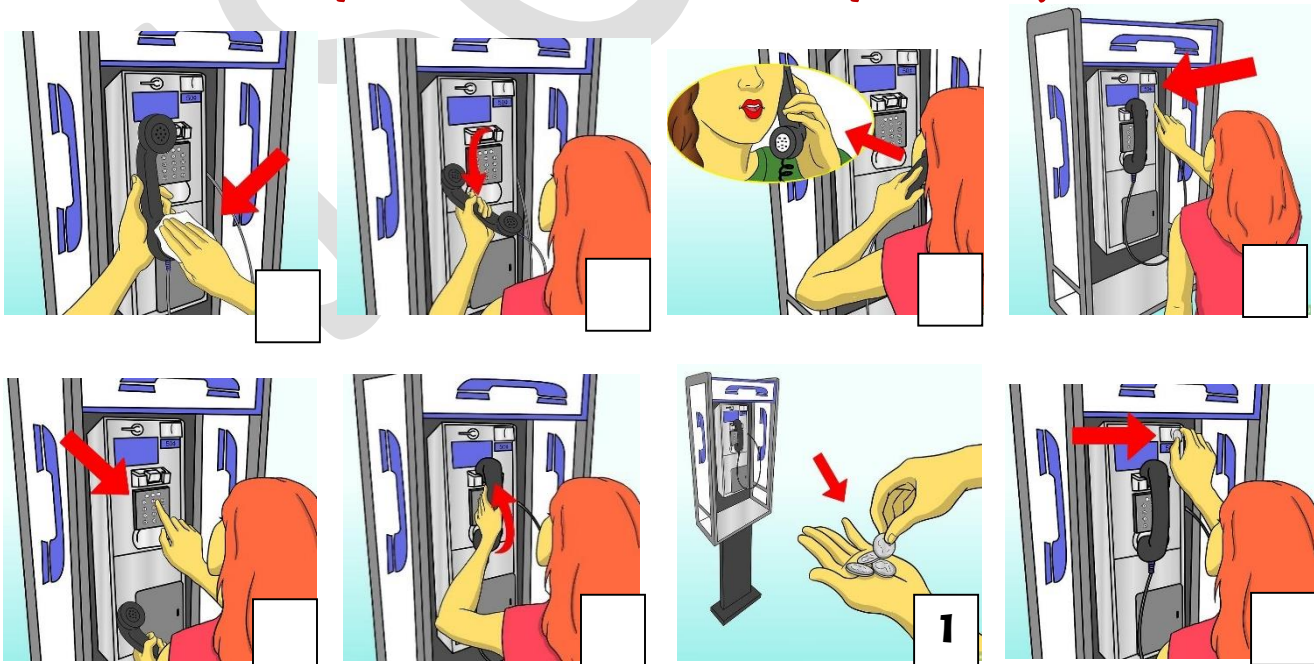
How to use a Pay Phone

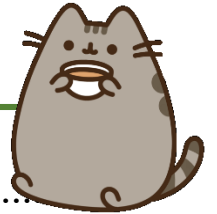

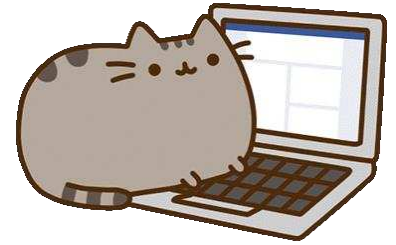
