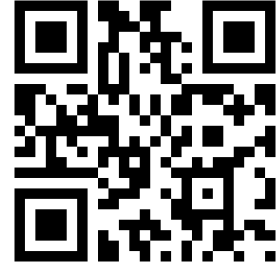

2-The advantages

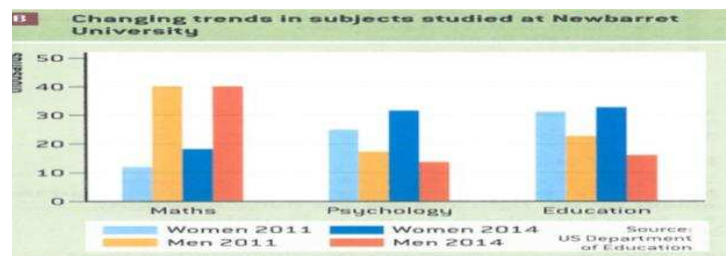

2-Describing a bar chart

*This bar chart gives information about the changing trends in subjects studied at Newbarret University.

**The vertical axis shows the number of students who study different subjects while the horizontal axis shows the subjects students are studying. It is clear from this bar chart that the number of women is higher than the number of men in studying different subjects.

***In maths, there were more men students than women. On the other hand, the number of women who studied education was higher than the number of men.

****Numbers increased during the period 2014 for women studying maths. There was a rise in the number of female students, from about 12,000 in 2011, to about 18,000 in 2014.

*****Overall, more students studied maths than other subjects. While Psychology had the smallest number of students enrolled.

3-(Describing a production process (making chocolate in a factory))

To begin with the beans of cocoa are roasted at the temperature of 135 c. Next the beans are crushed to remove the outer shells. Following this the inner parts of beans are pressed to be liquid chocolate. After that some sugar and milk are added to the liquid chocolate. Then the mixture is poured into moulds to cool down. Finally the bars of chocolate are wrapped in a foil and paper.

1-Introduction
