- 1- **Advert**: a picture, set of words, or a short film, which is intended to persuade people to buy a product or use a service, or that gives information about a job that is available, an event that is going to happen etc.
- 2- **Article**: a piece of writing about a particular subject in a newspaper or magazine
- 3- **Blog**: a web page containing information or opinions from a particular person or about a particular subject, to which new information is added regularly.
- 4- **Celebrity**: a famous living person
- 5- **Channel**: television station and all the programmes that it broadcasts.
- 6- **Drama**: a play for the theatre, television, radio etc, usually a serious one, or plays in general.
- 7- **Email**: a system that allows you to send and receive messages by computer
- 8- **Front page**: front-page news/article/story etc
- 9- **headline**: the title of a newspaper report, which is printed in large letters above the report
- 10- **Homepage**: the first page of a website, which often contains links to other pages on that website
- 11- **journalist**: someone who writes news reports for newspapers, magazines, television, or radio
- 12- **Presenter**: someone who introduces the different parts of a television or radio show



13- **Programme**: a series of actions which are designed to achieve something important

14- **social networking site**: a website where people put information about themselves and can send messages to other people

15- **spam**: to send the same message to many different people using email or the Internet, usually as a way of advertising something - used to show disapproval

16- **video**: a copy of a film or television programme, or a series of events, recorded on videotape

17- **Artist**: someone who produces art, especially paintings or drawings

18- **blogger**: someone who writes regularly for an online journal or website

19- **Photographer**: someone who takes photographs, especially as a professional or as an artist

20- **Politician**: someone who works in politics, especially an elected member of the government.

21- **Psychologist**: someone who is trained in psychology

22- **Reporter**: someone whose job is to write about news events for a newspaper, or to tell people about them on television or on the radio.

23- **Scientist**: someone who works or is trained in science.
