Read the following article about a freeconomist and answer the questions below accordingly:

**Living Without Money**

Mark Boyle is a 30- year- old freeconomist. A freeconomist is somebody who doesn't use money. But how is this possible? And how did Mark make the change to living without money?

The first thing he needed was somewhere to live. Luckily, he found a caravan that nobody wanted. Although Mark doesn't work for money, he volunteers on a farm three days a week in exchange for a place to put his caravan. As he can't pay bills for his home, he had to find a way to get energy: he burns wood for heating, he uses olive oil cans for cooking, and he has solar panel to collect energy from the sun to make electricity.

His caravan has lights, a laptop and a mobile phone (though he can only receive calls). Mark washes in a river (without soap) he uses natural things like fish bones and seeds as toothpaste.

He grows his own food on the farm where he lives, or finds wild food such as mushrooms and berries. He also gets waste food from restaurants or shops and exchanges food with other people. He owns a bike and cycles everywhere he needs to go. His clothes come from a free website.

Mark says that he is a happier person now that he lives this way, and he wants to continue living without money. 'It does have challenges, but I don't have the stress of bank accounts, bills, traffic jams, and long hours in a job I don't enjoy.'

Freeconomists like Mark say their way of life can help save the planet from climate change and pollution. As Mark explains, 'There's so much waste. If we all grew our own food, we would eat everything. If we all made our own tables and chairs, we wouldn't throw them away. If we had to clean our own drinking water, we wouldn't waste it.'
