Many people want to travel in ways that <u>because</u> [both] protect the environment and encourage sustainable tourism. At Green Adventures we understand and support those ideas too. This means that our travel company puts protecting nature first. We <u>but</u> [both] limit the number of tours we organize every year and limit the number of tourists we take on each tour. For example, we did an eco-tour in the Bahamas last year supported by a group of ocean scientists. We <u>often</u> [only] took ten tourists, and they were very lucky to see <u>between</u> [both] lemon sharks and tiger sharks in their natural environment.
