



This chart shows the results of a study carried out for the trends in US sales of e-book readers. The study compares sales from 2008 to 2016. The vertical axis shows shipments in million units while the horizontal axis shows the years that represent the comparison.

Overall, the survey shows that the number of sales of e-book readers in 2008 was only about 1 million. However, there was a significant increase in 2010. And after reaching a peak in 2011, sales of e-book readers have been falling again. In 2012, it reached about 14.9 million.

Between 2012 and 2013 there was a slight fall in sales and this fall continued until 2016 to reach only 7.1 million.
