



The given table above illustrates the information about consumers spending on different items in five different countries in 2002. It includes items such as food, clothing and leisure.

In terms of food, drinks and tobacco, Turkey spent the most at 32.14%. the consuming in Ireland was high also at 28.91% compared with Spain at 18.80%. while Italy spent 16.36% and Sweden 15.77% respectively. On the other hand, the lowest percentage was on leisure and education which accounted under 5% only in all countries. Turkey spent 4.35% on these items which is the double of Spain consuming as 1.98%. clothing and footwear was the third category of consumers goods as Italy rated 9% while the rest of other countries averaged around 6.5%.

Overall, the percentages of consuming that all countries spent most was food and tobacco as three times higher than other items. The lowest noticeable percentage was spent on leisure and education in all five countries.
