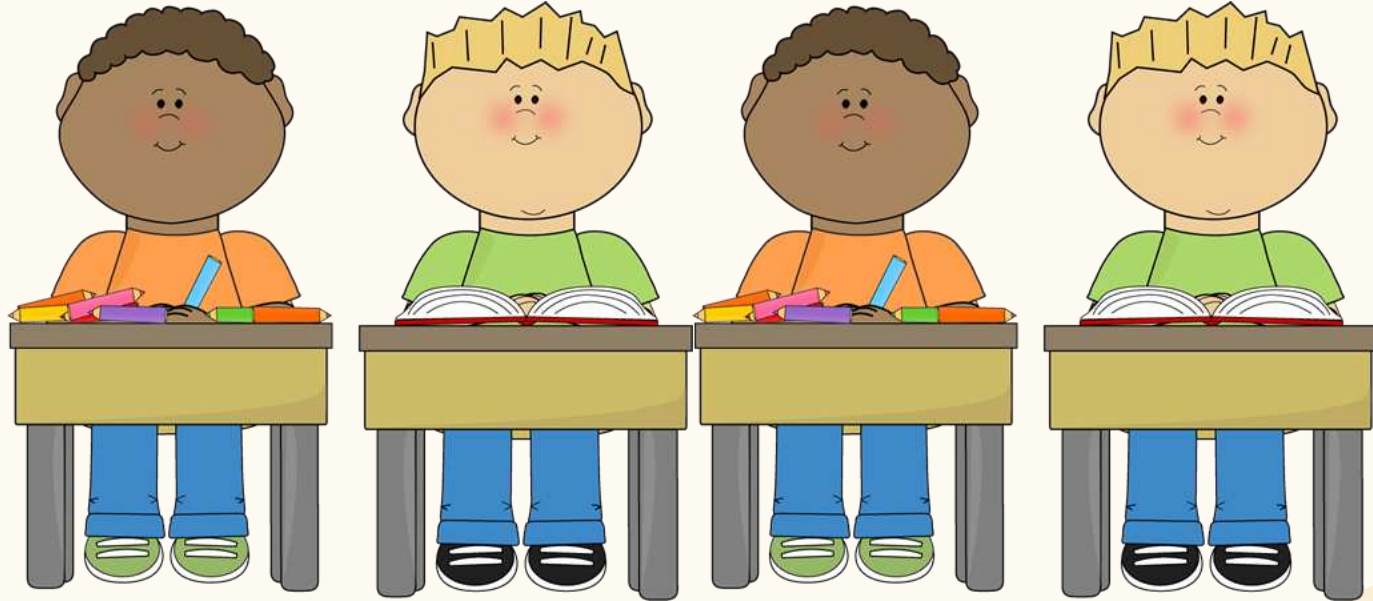

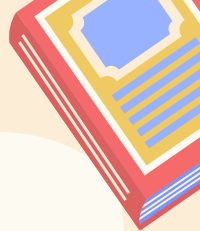

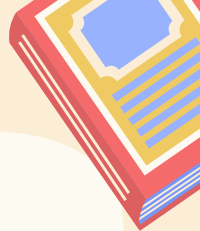

has	have
<p>He has been to Dubai.</p> <p>She has made a big cake.</p> <p>It has played in the garden.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• They have seen the movie .• We have eaten the lunch.• I have done the homework.• You have come to my party.





He/ She / It = has + past participle

They/ we / you / I = have + past participle



A: **Have**-----you -----**made** (make) your model town? I **have finished**-----
----- (finish) mine. Look!

B: That looks great! I **haven't started**----- (not / start) my model. Wow!
You've painted yours.

A: Yes, but you don't have to paint it. Look, Kim **hasn't painted**----- (not /
paint) hers.

B: I want to put a wall around my town. I **haven't seen**----- (see) some
great pictures. Look at this picture of a town in Italy.

A: My parents **have been**----- (go) to Italy. I would love to go too!

Subject + has / have + past participle verb + object.

I have been to the airport.



Use : be

Subject + has / have + past participle verb + object.

We have eaten ice-cream.



Use : eat



Subject + has / have + past participle verb + object.

He has played football.



Use : play
