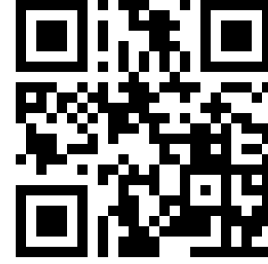

Flying machines

Drones are flying machines that we **control** from the ground. They don't have pilots! They carry cameras or other things. Many drones have important jobs.

In Rwanda, there are many hills and mountains. It takes a long time to travel between villages by car. Doctors use drones to get medicine or blood quickly. They **send a text** to people in a medical centre in the middle of the country. The people then prepare a box with the medicine. They put it on a drone and it flies to the doctors. The drone uses **satellites** to fly to the right place and **drop** the box.

Drones help wild animals too. In Borneo, scientists want to help and protect the orangutans. They study their nests at the top of tall trees. They're difficult to find, so the scientists use drones to fly over the forests and take photos.
