Most giant pandas are black and white, but not all. In the last 25 years, seven brown pandas have been seen in China, and Qizai is one of them. Qizai was is born in the wild, but now he lives in a nature reserve which is an area where animals are looked after, but have more space than in a zoo.

When Qizai was only two months old, his mother, who was black and white, left him alone in the mountains, and he became thin and sick. Luckily, someone found him .

At first, he was put with other pandas, but they always stole his food, probably because he looked different. Now Qizai has his own space to live in. Qizai doesn't move or eat as fast as the other pandas, but he eats the same plants. Like the other pandas, when someone call his name he goes to them.

Qizai is from the Qinling Mountains. Most of the pandas there are black and white, but even some of the black and white pandas have areas of brown hair .

Brown pandas have the same size teeth as other pandas, but because their heads and bodies are not as big, their teeth look bigger. Qizai is now old enough to be a father.
