
Lionel Messi started playing football at the age of five for a small club called Grandoli. Even as a young boy, he was a very good football player. When he was eleven, Messi joined the FC Barcelona Academy. The young player signed a contract with the club and left Argentina with his father to live in Spain.

In 2004, when he was only seventeen years old, Messi played his first match for FC Barcelona first team. In 2005, he became top scorer in the Champions League with six goals. 
Young Farmer




