Jamie Oliver is Britain's famous chef. He made his first TV cooking programme when he was only 23, got married at 25 and was given a special prize by the Queen at 28. A top supermarket used him in their advertisements for many years. His books on cooking sell better than any other food writer. For this reason, many journalists are always writing articles about him.

A few years ago, Jamie opened "Restaurant Fifteen" in London. The restaurant started because of a conversation Jamie had with his wife's friend. She worked with difficult children and found that they always enjoyed cooking, so Jamie decided to start a restaurant business to help young people with problems.
