Comparative forms for **short** adjectives




Comparative forms for short adjectives

First, read the examples and find out the grammatical rule.




1- The pink dress is **short**.



An adjective **without a comparative** form.



2- The pink dress is **shorter than the yellow one**.



An adjective **with a comparative** form.

Remember:

Vowels: a e i o u

consonants: The rest of the English alphabet.



Now the rule is:

Short (one-syllable) adjectives:

Rule	Spelling rule	Examples



Task 1



A) Rearrange the words to form comparative sentence.

Check your answers.

An example: than/ smaller/ Ali's shoes/ are/ mine/.

The answer: Ali's shoes are smaller than mine.

1- This blue shirt/ cheaper/ the black one/ is/ than/.

This blue shirt is cheaper than the black one.

2- nicer/ My new tie/ is/ than/ the old one/.

My new tie is nicer than the old one.



Task 2



B) Assess yourself by writing full sentences using the adjectives given with the comparative form on the next slide, then check your answers.

An example:

grey trousers



small

blue trousers



The grey trousers are smaller than the blue ones.

1- BD 10 **red boots**  **cheap** **brown boots**  BD 25

2- **green jacket**  **big** **orange jacket** 

- 1- The red boots are cheaper than the brown ones.
- 2- The green jacket is bigger than the orange one.



Comparative forms for **long** adjectives



Comparative forms for short adjectives

First, read the examples and find out the grammatical rule.



1- The pink dress is **expensive**. → An adjective **without a comparative** form.



2- The pink dress is **more expensive than the yellow one**. → An adjective **with a comparative** form.

Now the rule is:

long (more than one-syllable) adjectives:

Rule	Spelling rule	Examples



Task 3

An example: comfortable/ shorts/ more/ are/ tracksuits/ than/ more/ in hot weather/.

The answer: Shorts are more comfortable than tracksuits in hot weather.

1- Hamad's trousers/ comfortable/ Jassim's/ are/ than/ more/ .

Hamad's trousers are more comfortable than Jassim's.

2- fashionable/ is/ My new tie/ than/ my old one/ more/ .

My new tie is more fashionable than the old one.



Task 4



B) Assess yourself by writing full sentences using the adjectives given with the comparative form on the next slide, then check your answer.

An example:

blue trousers



grey trousers



comfortable

The blue trousers are more comfortable than the grey ones.

1- Tim's shorts



colourful



Jack's shorts

2- red coat



beautiful



black coat

1- Tim's shorts are more colourful than Jack's.

2- The red coat is more modern than the black one.
