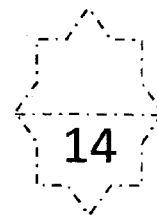
Nathan Taylor is an English teacher. He told his students about something happened to him when he was in school.

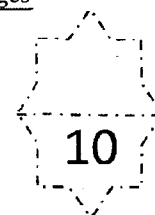

The Bataar Family, Ulan Bator, Mongolia

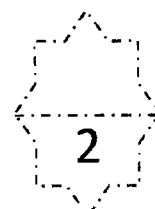

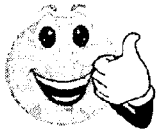
