

His job is mostly done in a kitchen, but sometimes he works in other places like wedding halls. He starts his work early in the morning. He tests the food for the breakfast meal and tests different kinds of juice. He also checks the amount of sugar in different drinks. Then, he smells and tastes vegetables and fruit arranged for lunch

He sometimes has to go to markets to buy the good ones himself. He tests boiled, fried, and grilled food, and gives advice to the chef. In the early evening, he starts checking the food for dinner. He tests every thing like salad, bread, soup, and sweets. My father says, 'I love food, and I love my job!'

A Tiring Work Day

My brother has a great job at the Science Centre. He is a daytime underwater photographer and he rarely works at night. He needs to be very careful. In the early morning, he goes to the centre and checks his tools like the camera and underwater breathing device. He wears his diving suit and fins. Then, he speaks to the divers to ask for information. After one hour, he is in water. He takes photos of many things like sand, coral reefs, fissures, ship wrecks and sea creatures.
