This research might load scientists to help hymnes with demaged.


This research might lead scientists to help humans with damaged body parts.



AN INCREDIBLE STORY OF SURVIVAL

John Smith is a great adventurer. He has been traveling across the sea, all his life. After their ship was crushed by pack ice, his crew abandoned the ship and planned to cross Antarctica on foot. Their aim became only to survive. Over two years, John led the crew across ice floes, then in lifeboats to camp on an island where they stayed for six months.
