Developing Spacecraft vs. Developing Robots

It's extremely important to develop new technology wisely, so that everyone can benefit from it. Some people believe our technology plan should focus on building spacecraft. Others believe it should focus on building robots. Which is the better course of action?

For those who dream of exploring outer space, the development of high-tech spacecraft is essential. But just one spaceship costs billions of dollars more to build than even the most complex robot. Many specialized robots could be designed and built much more cheaply than spaceships, and they could be used for practical purposes on Earth.

Many of the people who focus on future space exploration say it can solve key mysteries of space. This kind of knowledge is really fascinating, but there are no practical benefits from it for people on Earth right now. Robots will have new applications in the future, but even the robots we have now benefit us in practical ways. For example, they can work in dangerous conditions, such as places with extreme temperatures, doing very complicated surgeries and all useful things that benefit people right now.

To sum up, it's clearly better to give attention, time and money to the technological development of robots. They are less expensive to develop and more useful. Robots also benefit people in ways that are more practical than any benefit from a spacecraft

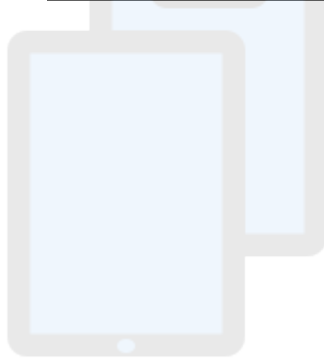

Shaikh Mohammed Bin Hamad Al Khalifa successfully climbed Mount Everest in May 2021. His team included members of the Bahrain Royal Guard, and they are the first Bahraini nationals to climb Mount Everest. They were also the first international team to conquer the new altitude (8,848.86 m.) of the world's tallest mountain.

Climbing Everest is an ambition for many experienced climbers because it's the highest peak in the world, but it requires a lot of experience and skill to get to the top safely. The climate of Everest is one of the most difficult things for climbers to manage. The weather on Everest can also change very suddenly, which makes it a dangerous environment for climbers.

The Bahraini team trained in the Himalayas in Nepal for a couple of months before embarking on their expedition to conquer Everest. They climbed several smaller mountains as part of their preparation. On the day they reached the summit of Everest, the team held the Bahraini flag at the top to mark their achievement.
