Walt Disney was a well-known film producer and an innovator in animation design. He created a number of the world's most famous animation heroes, like Mickey Mouse, Donald Duck, Felix the Cat and many others.

In his childhood, Walt moved with his family all around the United States. When young Walt arrived in Los Angeles, he had only \$40 and an unfinished cartoon in his suitcase.

Disney's first wish was to become a film director. Since he didn't succeed in live-action films, Disney turned back to animation. His first Hollywood cartoon "studio" was a garage in his uncle's house. Walt went to his brother Roy and asked for his help with opening the studio. Roy agreed and this was the beginning of the Disney Brothers' Studio.

Walt Disney died on December 15, 1966, several years before the opening of his "Walt Disney World" dream project in Orlando, Florida. The famous Disneyland and Walt Disney World resort parks in the United States, France, Japan and China were named in his memory.



A The City Farm is for everyone who loves animals and wants to learn more about this working farm in the heart of the city. There are cows, sheep and chickens, and cheese and butter are made in the dairy. The farm is open daily. Children under 12 must come with an adult.
B The Local Community Sports Centre offers a variety of activities - table tennis, snooker, indoor football and karate. It is open six days a week from 5 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.; a small charge is made for the use of equipment.
The Nature Club meets at weekends in the country, usually on a Sunday afternoon. Members take part in walks and discussions. All age groups are welcome.
The Play Centre provides free entertainment for the under fives with indoor and outdoor play areas. You may leave your child here for up to two hours at a time in any one day.
The Potter Centre is organized for people who don't work anymore. It opens five days a week from 11:30 to 6:00. Cheap hot meals are provided at lunchtimes and different activities take place every afternoon. There is also a monthly theatre tour.
F The Adventure Playground in Rowan Street was built for children up to the age of 14. There are ropes, swings, slides and tree climbs with an adult in charge at all times. Open during school holidays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. A small charge is payable for each child.
