There are six questions in this part. For each question, there are three pictures and a short recording. Choose the correct picture and put a tick ($\sqrt{}$) in the box below it . You will hear the recording twice.

You have two minutes to read the questions. [pause]

Now we are ready to start. Listen carefully. You will hear the recording twice.

Number 1: What time will James meet Alex?

Man: Hello Alex. It's James. Listen, I know I said I'd come over to your place at 6 o'clock but something has come up at work and I have to stay here until 6:30, which means I will meet you at your house at 7:00. If that's too late for you, let me know and we'll arrange to meet some other time.

Number 2: What will the boy buy his mum?

Number 3: Which class will the man take?

Man: Nope. Mary wants to take a class with me and she has decided on dancing.

Number 4: When is the school Eco-bazaar?
