Write an essay of 110 – 130 words to compare and contrast your personality with that of a family member or friend.


I come from a large family with many aunts and uncles, but not as similar as each other.

Unit 5 Classification essay

Write a classification essay of 110–130 words to describe two types of animal flight.

You may use this plan:

Paragraph 1: Introduction, state which two animals you are going to describe
Paragraph 2: describing the flight of one animal (Support with fact)
Paragraph 3: describing the flight of the second animal (Support with fact)
Paragraph 4: conclusion, a statement about the two animals

Flight can be seen in three types of animals: birds, insects, and bats.



However, there are other animals that can glide or appear to fly, such as the Colugo. Bats are the only mammals that can fly and they do so using their webbed wings made of thin skin that stretches out from their fingers. They use an advanced navigation system while flying.

On the other hand, the Colugo is not a lemur and does not have wings, but it has flaps of skin between its legs, tail, and neck which help it glide through the forest. Even though wings are important for flying, not having them doesn't necessarily mean an animal can't fly.
