

Amy Johnson was a famous British pilot and one of the first women to learn to fly. She was born on 1st July 1903 in Northern England. She became interested in aviation while working as a secretary in London. In 1928, she was awarded her pilot's licence. In May 1930, she attempted to beat the record for a solo flight from Britain to Australia. She flew alone from London to Darwin in a small aeroplane called Jason. The journey took 19 days. Although she missed the record by three days; she was very popular with the British public. When she returned home, many people went to the airfield to welcome her. The British press called her, "The Queen of the air".

Amy Johnson made many other long-distance flights and broke several records. She flew from Japan to Siberia in 1931. Five years later, she broke the record for a solo flight from London to Cape Town in South Africa. She made some of her flights alone and some with her husband, Jim Mollison, who was also a famous pilot. In 1933, when they flew from London to New York, she became the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean from east to west. She also flew planes for the army during the Second World War. In January 1941, she was killed in a plane crash just off the British coast.
