

Trying to make sense of the brain's incredible complexity isn't easy. What we know is that it's the organ that makes us human by making decisions and producing rational thought. It's also responsible for each individual's personality .

Your brain contains about 100 billion microscopic cells called neurons . Whenever you make any movement , signals race between these neurons . Countless messages zip around inside it every second . Your neurons in your skin send this information to your brain at a speed of more than 240 kilometres per hour . Your brain uses other neurons to send the message back to your foot to shake the bee off quickly .
