Due to a sharp increase in its aging population, China faces new social problems in the future. In China, the elderly people aged 60 or older make up about 11 percent of the population. By 2050, the number of the elderly will increase to more than 31 percent. If this continues, the elderly could outnumber young people.

While lower birthrates and higher life expectancies are causing similar population shifts in many countries, this transformation is happening faster in China due to the strict one-child policy introduced in 1979. This policy's purpose was to stop China's population from growing too fast. It created a generation of "only children" growing up without brothers or sisters who can share the burden of caring for elderly family members.
