Space tourism which was once only a dream is now becoming a reality. After the first man landed on the moon in 1969, they thought that hotels would be built on the moon. Furthermore, people thought of the possibility that families might go for a holiday on the moon. Neither of these predictions has come true yet - but the rapid development of technology may mean these predictions are a possibility in the coming years.  Space Adventures is currently the only company to have succeeded in sending paying passengers into space. Space Adventures worked with the Federal Space Agency to facilitate flights for the world's first private space explorers. Each person paid over \$20 million for their 10-day trip to the International Space Station. The American businessman Dennis Tito was the world's first space tourist. Tito flew into space aboard a Russian Soyuz rocket that arrived at the International Space Station on April 2001. The second space tourist was, South African businessman, Mark Shuttleworth. On September 2006, Anousheh Ansari became the first female space tourist. As a result of the several successful explorations into space, several companies are now considering the possibility of enabling tourists to visit space.  Passengers would be transported to a height of between 100-160km above earth, experience 3-6 minutes of weightlessness and a view of the stars before being taken back down to earth. This is expected to cost around \$200,000 per person. Whilst it could be an enriching experience, there are some disadvantages to space tourism. Many people have said that a huge growth in the spaceflight industry could drastically speed up the process of global warming. The ozone layer would be damaged further, and the polar regions would suffer. In addition, space travel is only a possibility for the super-rich. Although Virgin Galactic claims to be "opening space to the rest of us", there are still millions of people worldwide who wouldn't be able to afford it.
