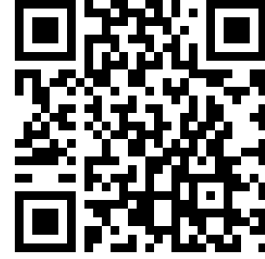

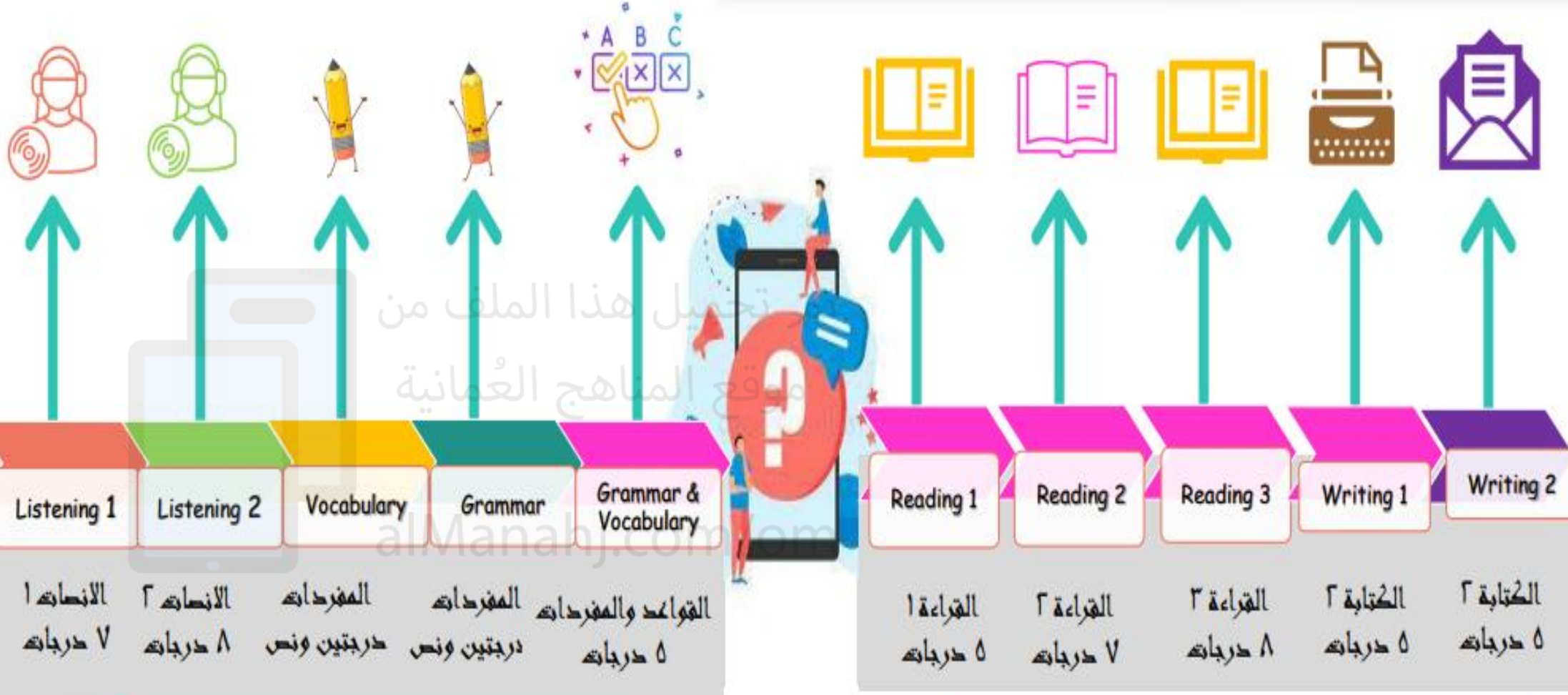

If you are looking for a place to do voluntary work, I can highly recommend Arequipa, the second largest city in Peru. Many of its people live in poor conditions and suffer from all sorts of problems. So as a volunteer, you can really make yourself useful!

In particular, I would like to tell you about 'Intiwawa', a non-governmental organization which was founded in 2007. The name means 'Children of the Sun' and its aim is to improve the health and education of the city's poor children. 'Intiwawa' started very small, with just a few local volunteers, but since then it has expanded rapidly. By 2010, it already had 70 volunteers from all around the world; now, it has 200!

'Intiwawa' depends completely on the work of these volunteers to carry out its projects. Volunteers can come from any country, but they have to be eighteen years old or over, and must have a positive attitude. They should also, if possible, have a good level of Spanish in order to communicate with the children. They get a return ticket to Peru from their country of origin. Once arrived, they are provided with low-cost housing and free meals every day. They have to stay for at least four weeks, so that they develop relationships with the children and families that they are helping.

The job is to work with children aged 3-18 years old. From my own experience, I can tell you: these kids are fantastic! They are divided into different age groups. Volunteers may be asked to help in the day-care centre supporting a teacher with children aged 3 to 5. Or they may work in the main hall with the largest group aged 6 to 14, helping them with their homework and, after that, organizing games. They may also teach English or give computer classes to children who are between 15 and 18.

'Intiwawa' has a special place in my heart. I planned to stay for just two months, but it ended up as six! And next year, I'm going back there again! In order to achieve its goals, 'Intiwawa' needs as much support as it can get from motivated and energetic volunteers. So why not try it? It will probably change your life!

News reports had been saying that a powerful hurricane was going to hit the town in the coming hours. For me as a child it meant nothing. I didn't know what a hurricane was; I had never experienced one. However, my parents had told me stories of the destruction that the last hurricane had caused thirty years ago.

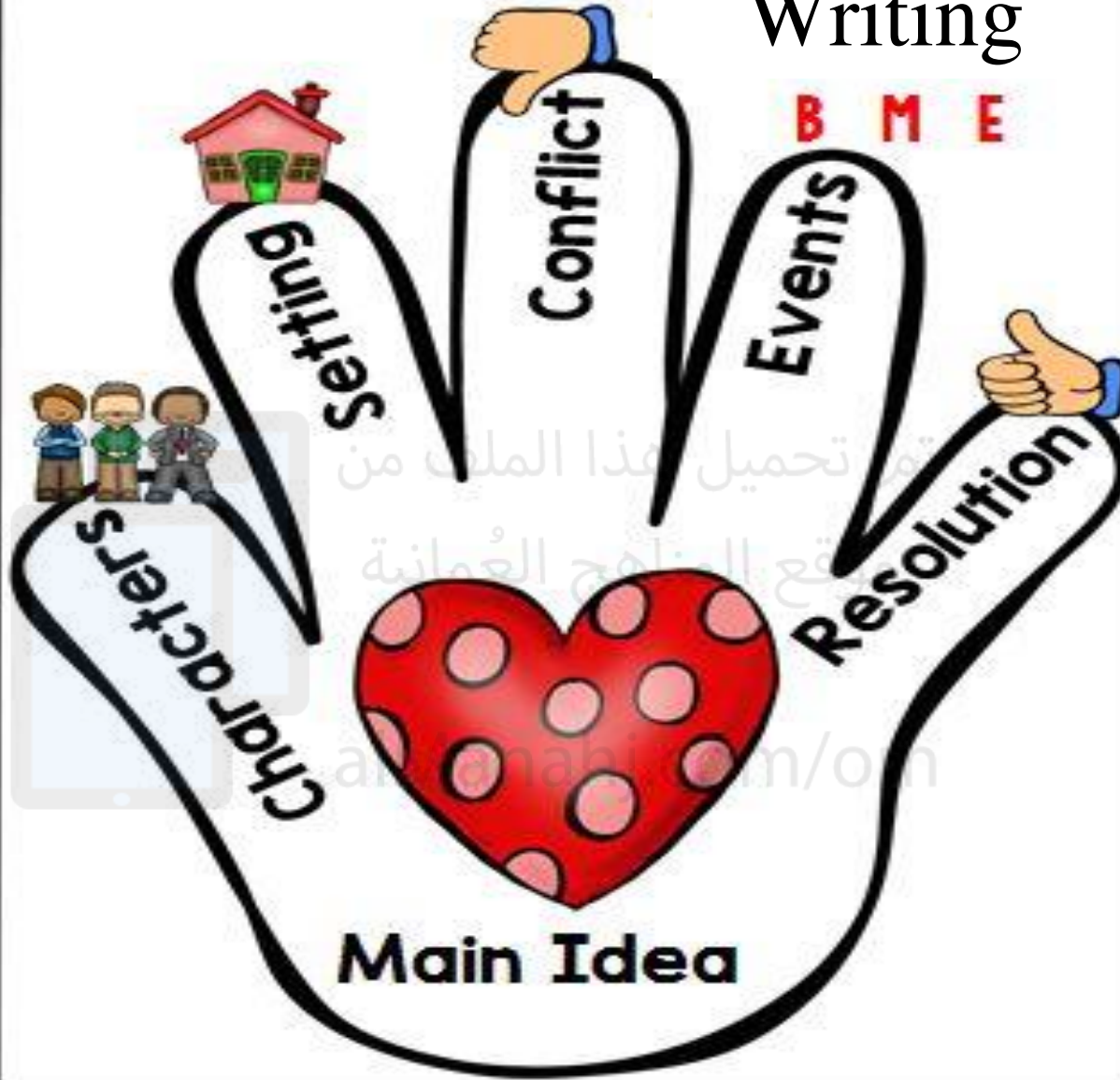

My Summer

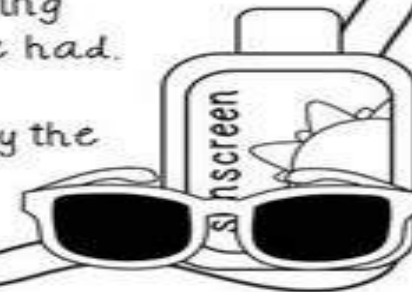
