- They had played football **before** they ate their lunch.
- **After** we had seen the film in the cinema, we went home.
- **Before** my friend arrived, I'd finished my homework.
- She didn't watch TV **until** she had done her homework.

After

As soon as

past perfect (had + p.p.) + past simple

- **After / As soon as** I had written the letter, I posted it.
- Ahmed helped his father **after / as soon as** he had come home.

Before

When

past simple + past perfect (had + p.p.)

- **Before / When** I posted the letter, I had written it.
- Ahmed had come home **before / when** he helped his father.

didn't + inf. + until / till + past perfect (had + p.p.)

- I didn't post the letter **until / till** I had written it.
- Ahmed didn't help his father **until** he had come home.

past simple + because + past perfect (had + p.p.)

- Our team won the match **because** they had played well.
