Amelia Earhart was born on 24th July, 1897, in the USA, in a small town in Kansas. She lived there until she was ten, but then her mother took her to live in the city of Chicago. From 1916 to 1918, she experienced the horrors of the 1st World War working as a nurse in a military hospital.

After the war, Amelia joined the Medical Faculty at Columbia University. However, her love of flying was born when her father took her to a show. During this event, she was given a ride in a plane. She had never been in a plane before, and it was an experience she would never forget!

She started taking flying lessons from a female pilot. She learned quickly, and in 1920 was able to fly for the first time without an instructor. Two years later, she broke her first record when she reached a height of 4,600 metres.

In 1926, two well-known male pilots invited her to take part in a flight across the Atlantic Ocean. However, she was only a passenger. The plane was actually flown by the two men, but Amelia became the first woman to make the trip across the Atlantic.

Five years later, Amelia made her own journey across the Atlantic. She became not only the first woman to fly across the ocean alone, but also the only person to have crossed in both directions. She also broke the record for the longest flight by a woman.

In April 1935, Amelia was ready to achieve her dream: a round-the-world flight! Unfortunately, it did not begin well. She crashed during take-off, and then had to wait for two years until the plane was repaired. Finally, she was able to leave. She flew eastwards across the Atlantic Ocean to Africa, then across the Indian Ocean to Australia, where she did some small repairs on the plane.

After flying to New Guinea, she headed across the huge emptiness of the Pacific Ocean. However, as she was getting near to her destination, the Howland Islands, her navigation system failed, and she got lost. She sent several radio calls for help, but no one replied. Finally, the plane had no more petrol. Amelia was never seen or heard from again.
