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Theme 4: Present Perfect Simple

Affirmative:

Subject + has / have + past participle + complement

He	has	started	Complement
She		gone	
It		bought	
I	have	played	
We		done	
They		studied	
You		been	

Examples:

- 1- He has lost his book.
- 2- She's written a story. (She's = She has)
- 3- They've gone out. (They've = They have)
- 4- We have done our homework.
- 5- I have washed the car.

already, just , never ,..... before main verb.

Examples:

- 1- She has never stayed at a hotel.
- 2- They have never climbed Mount Everest.
- 3- He has just done his homework.
- 4- We have already started our new job.
- 5- I have just had dinner.

For / Since

- Since + time , date or event in the past
- For + a period of time

Examples:

- 1- Nour has been in Japan for three months.
- 2- Nour has been in Japan since August.
- 3- We have lived here for 20 years.
- 4- I have been much happier since I met you.
- 5- Oman has changed a lot since 1970.

gone / been

Examples:

- Mazin and Nour have gone to Germany. = They are in Germany now.
- Mazin and Nour have been to Germany. = They went to Germany, but now they are back.

Examples:

- 1- “ I have never been to Canada , but I hope to go next year.”
- 2- “ Sorry you can’t speak to Futoon. She’s gone home.”

Examples:

- 1-They haven't worked today.
- 2-She hasn't seen him for a long time.
- 3-We haven't tidied up our rooms.
- 4-Ali hasn't repaired his car.
- 5-I haven't watered the plants.

Interrogative:

Have	I we they you	studied played invited met ridden	Complement?
Has	he she it	read seen	

Examples:

- 1- Have you seen Aysha? Yes , I have. / or / No , I haven't.
- 2- Has she called us? Yes, she has. / or / No , she hasn't.
- 3- Has the headmaster signed the letter? Yes , he has. / or / No , he hasn't.
- 4- Have they got the letter? Yes , they have. / or / No , they haven't.
- 5- Has it rained a lot? Yes , it has. / or / No , it hasn't

Wh- Question:

Where	has	it	bought	Complement ?
What		he	studied	
When	have	she	asked	
How often		I	seen	
Who		we	written	
How much		they	spent	
Why		we	invited	

Examples:

- 1- Where have they met him?
- 2- How often has she written the sentence?
- 3- What have they built?

ever == (in your life) ----- (questions)

Has	he she it	ever	eaten drunk visited	Complement ?
Have	I we they you		come walked caught bought	

Examples:

- 1- Have you ever visited London? Yes, I have. / or / No , I haven't.
- 2- Have we ever met before? yes , we have. / or / No , we haven't.
- 3- Has Reem ever flown in a plane? Yes , she has. / or / No , she hasn't.

Yet == (until now) == (end) Questions and negative sentences :

Questions : Have/Has + Subject + past participle + Complement + yet?

Has	he she it	arrested forgotten stopped had arrived left broken	Complement	yet?
Have	I we they you			

Examples:

- 1- Has she finished writing her story yet?
- 2- Have you met the new teacher yet?
- 3- Have they learned to speak English yet?

Negative (Ye): Subject + hasn't/haven't + past participle + complement + yet.

He She It	has not hasn't	Beaten begun lost	Complement	yet.
I We They You	have not haven't	won rung paid chosen		

Examples:

- 1- I haven't sent the email yet.
- 2- Ali hasn't started school yet.
- 3- They haven't learned to use a computer yet.

Yet (Questions and negatives)

- 1- Have you finished your homework yet?
 No, I haven't finished my homework yet. but
 Yes , I have already finished my homework.
- 2- Has the film started yet?
 No , it hasn't started yet. but
 Yes , it has already started.
- 3- Have they visited their friend yet?
 No , they haven't visited him yet. but
 Yes , they have already visited him.



Affirmative:

Subject + have / has + been + (verb + ing) + complement.

He	has	been	learning	complement
She			waiting	
It			speaking	
I	taking			
We	watching			
They	travelling			
You	have	working		

Examples:

- 1- We have been learning English for seven years.
- 2- She has been working since four o'clock.
- 3- I have been doing my homework for twenty minutes.

Negative:

Subject + haven't / hasn't + been + (verb + ing) + complement

He	hasn't (has not)	been	doing	complement
She			washing	
It			playing	
I	walking			
We	haven't (have not)		going	
They	swimming			
You	calling			

Examples:

- 1- Noura hasn't been doing her homework.
- 2- We haven't been learning French for three years.
- 3- I haven't been watching television since yesterday.

Interrogative:

Have / Has + Subject + been + (verb + ing) + Complement.

Has	he she it	been	reading running raining	Complement?
Have	I we they you		working smoking playing repairing	

Examples:

- 1- Has she been playing chess this week?
- 2- Have they been reading their lessons today?
- 3- Have you been writing your e-mails?
- 4- How long has he been talking about his problem?
- 5- How long have you been playing football?
