### Listening 1

### Listening 2:

Dolphins are smart sea animals. They are good swimmers. Dolphins can stay for 15 minutes underwater. They have a blowhole on their head to breathe with. They eat animals like fish, seals and turtles. Dolphins live mostly in oceans and some rivers near the coast. They like riding the waves. They live in groups called "Pods". They work together to find food, protect each other and play. Currently there are 42 dolphin species. The smallest dolphin is 1.2 metres long and weighs 40 kg. The largest dolphin is about 9.5 long metres and weighs 10 tons. The largest dolphin is called Orca. Dolphins are easy to train because they are very smart. They understand humans and they react towards sign language: for example if a man would like a dolphin to jump, he would move his hand upwards, immediately he can see the dolphin jumps. Unfortunately, dolphins are at risk because oceans are being polluted.
