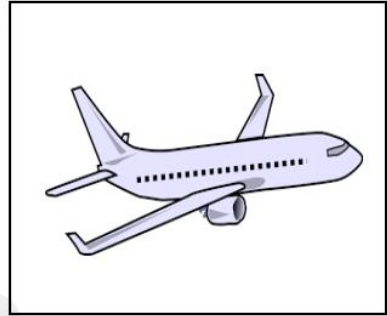

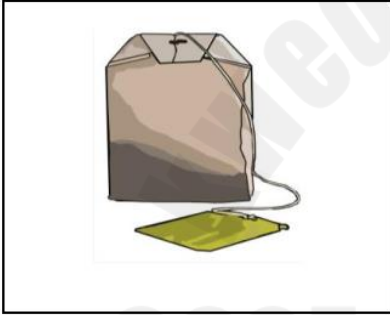

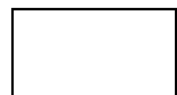

Urban Zoos are located in large cities. This type was popular 200 years ago. It is smaller than other zoos. In many urban zoos, animals are kept in relatively small enclosures. They are common in Europe,

Safari Parks are larger than urban Zoos. Safari parks are areas where tourists can drive their own cars to see non-native wildlife animals living in large, enclosed areas. These attractions allow the animals more space than the small enclosures of traditional zoos.

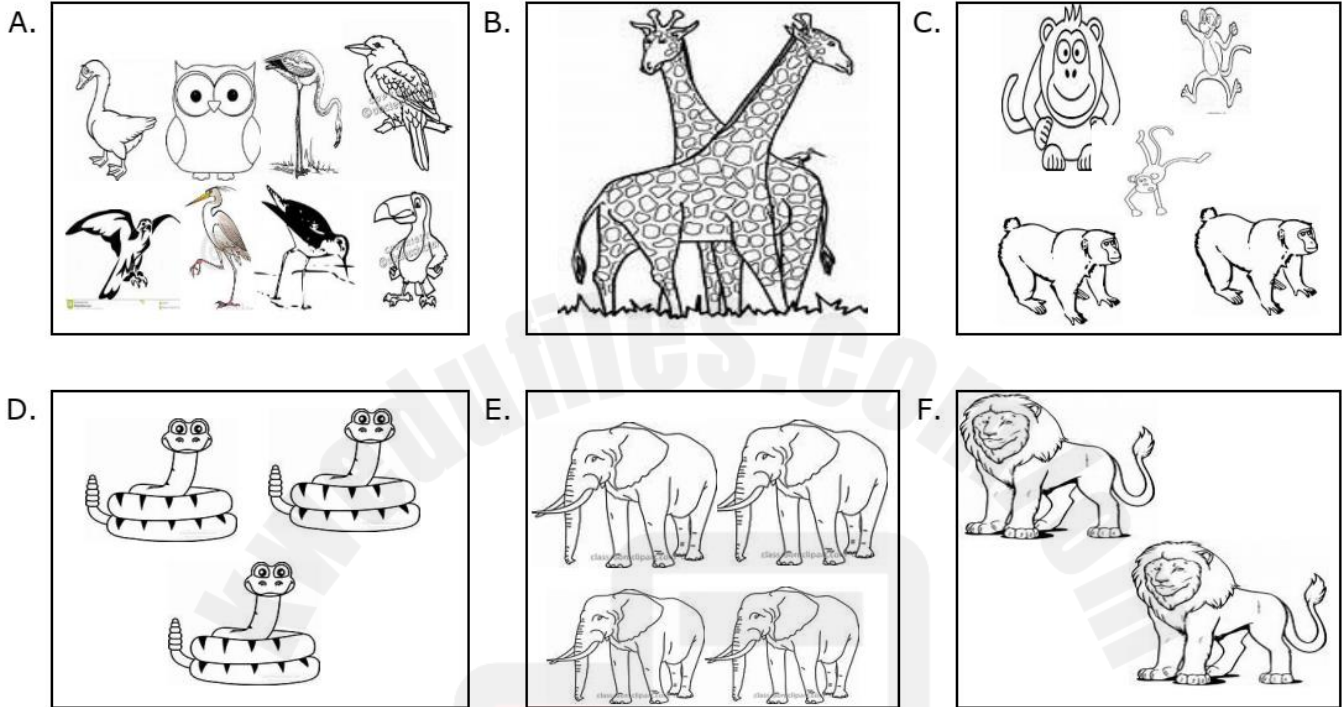
