

Message to the intended reader(s) is fairly clear. - Writing succeeds to a large extent in achieving its purpose. 5 - Uses language which is appropriate to reader and context. - A fair range of structures and vocabulary, with a good level of accuracy. Message to the intended reader(s) is partially clear. - Writing has reasonable success in achieving its purpose. 4 There are clear attempts to use language appropriate to reader and context. - Grammar and vocabulary are reasonably correct, though limited in range. Message to the intended reader(s) is <u>mixed</u>. - Writing has partially achieved its main purpose. 3 Some of the language used is inappropriate to reader and context. There is a noticeable lack of accuracy in the use of grammar and vocabulary. Message to the intended reader(s) is mostly unclear. - Writing only has very limited success in achieving its purpose. 2 - There is little evidence of attempts to use appropriate language. - Grammar/Vocabulary contain frequent serious errors. <u>Note 1</u>: The task is to write a **letter**/ an **e-mail**, so students <u>must</u> include a greeting at the start <u>and</u> a closing at the end. If they do not, they will lose marks. <u>PROCEDURE</u>: Each marker marks the <u>content</u> of the e-mail according to the Rating Scale — then, if either the greeting or the closing are <u>missing</u>, **deduct one mark** from the content-score.

Note 2: No marks should be awarded or deducted for the address. Any addresses should be ignored.
