Palm trees are a family of plants. They grow in hot climates. There are two types of palm trees. They are Date palm and Coconut palm. There are over two thousand kinds, living in many kinds of places from rainforests to deserts.

Palms are one of the most well-known tree families. They have had an important role to people through history. Many common products and foods come from palms, and they are also used a lot in parks and gardens in areas that are not very cold.

Palm trees have 3 main parts. Most palms are a long straight stem. They have large green leaves that are arranged in a spiral at the top of the trunk. The flowers grow on a special branch just for carrying the great number of small flowers. The flowers are generally small and white, and they have the shape of stars. The familiar coconut is the seed of a large fruit. Some kinds may contain two or more seeds in each fruit.

Most of palms live in tropical forests. Other palms live on tropical mountains above 1000 meters, Palms may also live in lands with grass and usually where there is water, and in desert oases.
