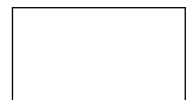

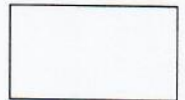

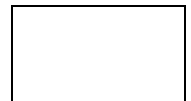

Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque is Oman's largest and grandest mosque, located in the heart of Muscat with magnificent gardens around it. It was designed by the Iranian architect Mohammed Makeyya. The building works lasted for six years. It was opened by Sultan Qaboos in 2001.

The mosque is mainly made of stone, with doors and windows made of wood and glass. Around 300,000 tons of sandstone were brought for building from India. There are also five minarets which have been built around the mosque and a very big dome with fascinating Islamic designs.

This mosque is built on a site occupying 416 thousand metres. Moreover, the mosque is the largest in Oman. It has a capacity of 20,000 prayers: 6,500 in the main prayer hall, 1,500 in the women's prayer hall and further 12,000 in the outer ground.

In addition, the carpet of the mosque is the second largest one in the world. It took four years to be completed because it was hand made in Iran.
