BE WEB WISE

1 Protect your computer, by all means, but don't forget to protect yourself, advises web safety expert, Amanda Knox. We're always encouraged to stay safe online. But as time goes on, the internet becomes part of our everyday lives, including work, fun, study and shopping, and it's not always easy to spot the dangers. Web safety expert, Amanda Knox, explores some of the issues in cyberspace.

2 Web safety specialists say better personal awareness is needed in 'Social Networking' sites like 'Facebook' or 'Twitter', which allow us to connect with people around the world with similar interests and professional backgrounds. Do the people you meet online really deserve your trust? Can you be sure the person you're chatting with is in fact a 22-year-old young man from London and not someone else from another country? A person later realizes that it was unwise to post a phone number or an email address in the public chat.

3 When networking and joining online communities, it's better to be cautious about the amount of personal information you share. For example, try not to use your real name as a username. You could instead use a nickname, or a name that doesn't give away your real identity to other users. And it is **essential** not to tell the world details about your school, college or any local clubs you're a member of.

4 So, how to stop yourself from being hacked or getting your personal data stolen? Amanda Knox gives you some advice on how to do that. Her first piece of advice is to install software and a firewall to protect your computer from hackers and criminals who want to steal your data or financial information. And the second one is to keep a regular back-up of your data in case you get hacked.

5 If you do experience problems from another user, there are always ways to be taken into consideration. A general way is not to post any information about yourself that you would not be happy for the world to know, including photographs of yourself, particularly which you may later regret! Another way is to be prepared to report any user for misusing the service.

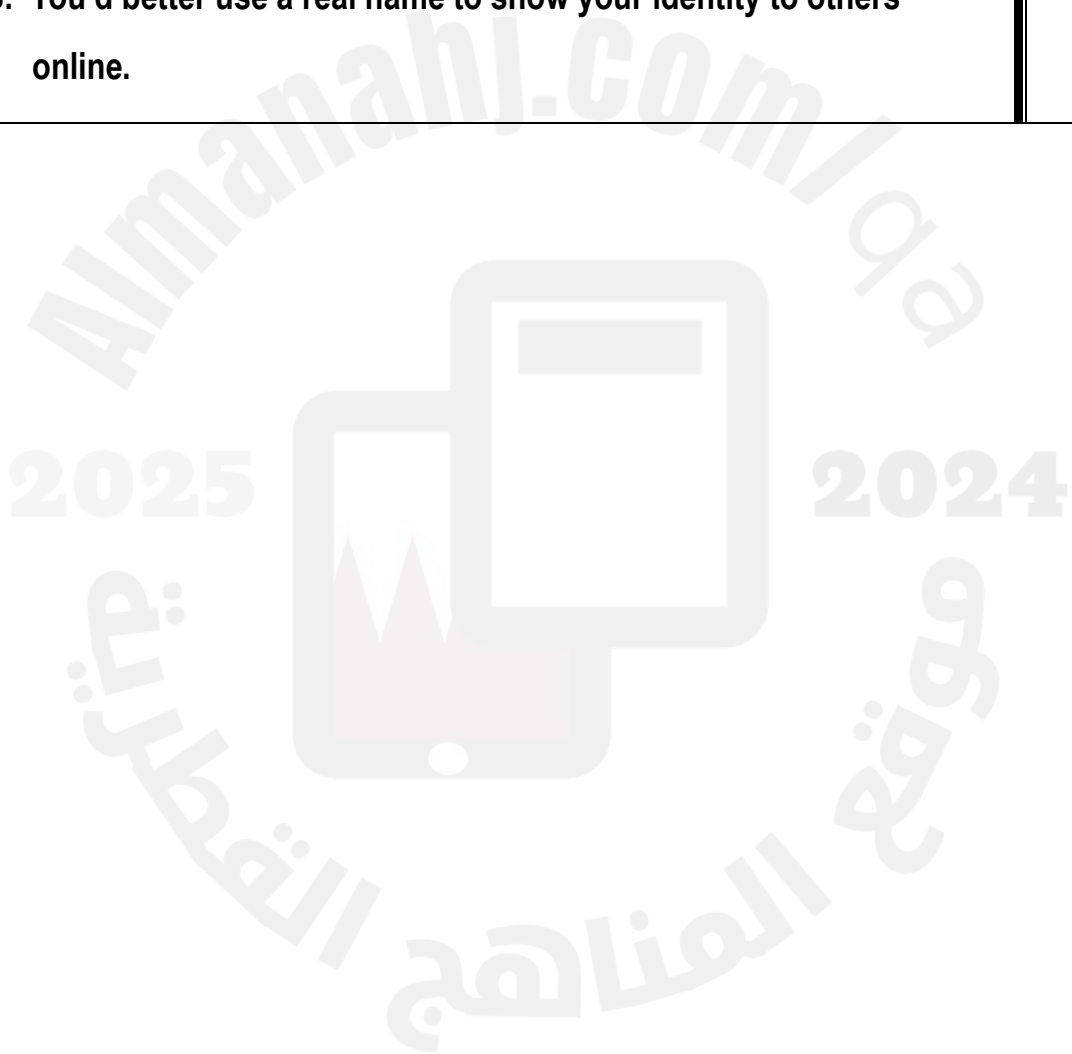
