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



Tariq, a forty-year-old Omani businessman, believed that travelling to foreign countries and meeting new people would be a good and interesting way to learn more about the world and improve the mind.
- 2. On the 1<sup>st</sup> of October, Tariq started his journey with a flight from Muscat to London. He planned to spend two weeks in England and Scotland, about the same time in the rest of Europe and fly back home at the end of the month. He was particularly keen to see Switzerland and Paris because he had seen beautiful pictures of the Alps mountains and the Eiffel Tower and also because he wanted to expand his business in Paris. On the 13th of October, Tariq was already home. Why did he have to cut short his holiday?
- 3. Tariq found that travelling abroad was not so easy! He had to face a number of problems on his trip. First of all, he hired a car but was utterly confused about driving on the left in England! Secondly, he found it impossible to manage without knowing any French in the smaller cities of France. He also missed his family terribly and was homesick for most of the time. 
