Earth, our home, is the third planet from the sun. It's the only planet known to have an atmosphere containing free oxygen, oceans of water on its surface and, of course, life.

Earth is the fifth largest of the planets in the solar system. It's smaller than the four gas giants — Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune — but larger than the three other rocky planets, Mercury, Mars and Venus.

Earth has a diameter of roughly 8,000 miles (13,000 kilometers) and is round because gravity pulls matter into a ball. But, it's not perfectly round. Earth is really an "oblate spheroid," because its spin causes it to be squashed at its poles and swollen at the equator.

Earth has a diameter of roughly 8,000 miles (13,000 kilometers) and is round because gravity pulls matter into a ball. But, it's not perfectly round. Earth is really an "oblate spheroid," because its spin causes it to be squashed at its poles and swollen at the equator.

Water covers roughly 71 percent of Earth's surface, and most of that is in the oceans. About a fifth of Earth's atmosphere consists of oxygen, produced by plants. While scientists have been studying our planet for centuries, much has been learned in recent decades by studying pictures of Earth from space.

Earth's orbit

While Earth orbits the sun, the planet is simultaneously spinning on an imaginary line called an axis that runs from the North Pole to the South Pole. It takes Earth 23.934 hours to complete a rotation on its axis and 365.26 days to complete an orbit around the sun.

Earth's axis of rotation is tilted in relation to the ecliptic plane, an imaginary surface through the planet's orbit around the sun. This means the Northern and Southern hemispheres will sometimes point toward or away from the sun depending on the time of year, and this changes the amount of light the hemispheres receive, resulting in the seasons.

Earth's orbit is not a perfect circle, but rather an oval-shaped ellipse, similar to the orbits of all the other planets. Our planet is a bit closer to the sun in early January and farther away in July, although this variation has a much smaller effect than the heating and cooling caused by the tilt of Earth's axis. Earth happens to lie within the so-called "Goldilocks zone" around the sun, where temperatures are just right to maintain liquid water on our planet's surface.

1 On August 12th, 2012, Katerina Antosova is standing on a ladder in her garden and picking pears. At this time, she is 47 years old, a happily married mother of three, a sports fan and a career woman. Today she is still the same despite how much her life changed within seconds on that day in august: a branch broke, she fell from four meters high and injured her spine. Since then, she has been paralyzed from the waist down.

2 Five years later, Katerina has become not only a blogger, book author and a master of her wheelchair, but a top athlete with her hand-operated leaning bicycle, the so-called Hand bike. And when asked about the secret of her strength, Katerina shakes her head: “There are no tricks”, she says. “I am simply a woman who loves her life and tries making the best out of it.” It is with this mindset that she was able to participate at the Paralympics in Rio de Janerio|

3 “I have always loved speed. I guess I need the adrenaline kick. What stressed me out the most after my accident was the idea that I would have to move around awfully slowly in a wheelchair. That would have driven me crazy.”

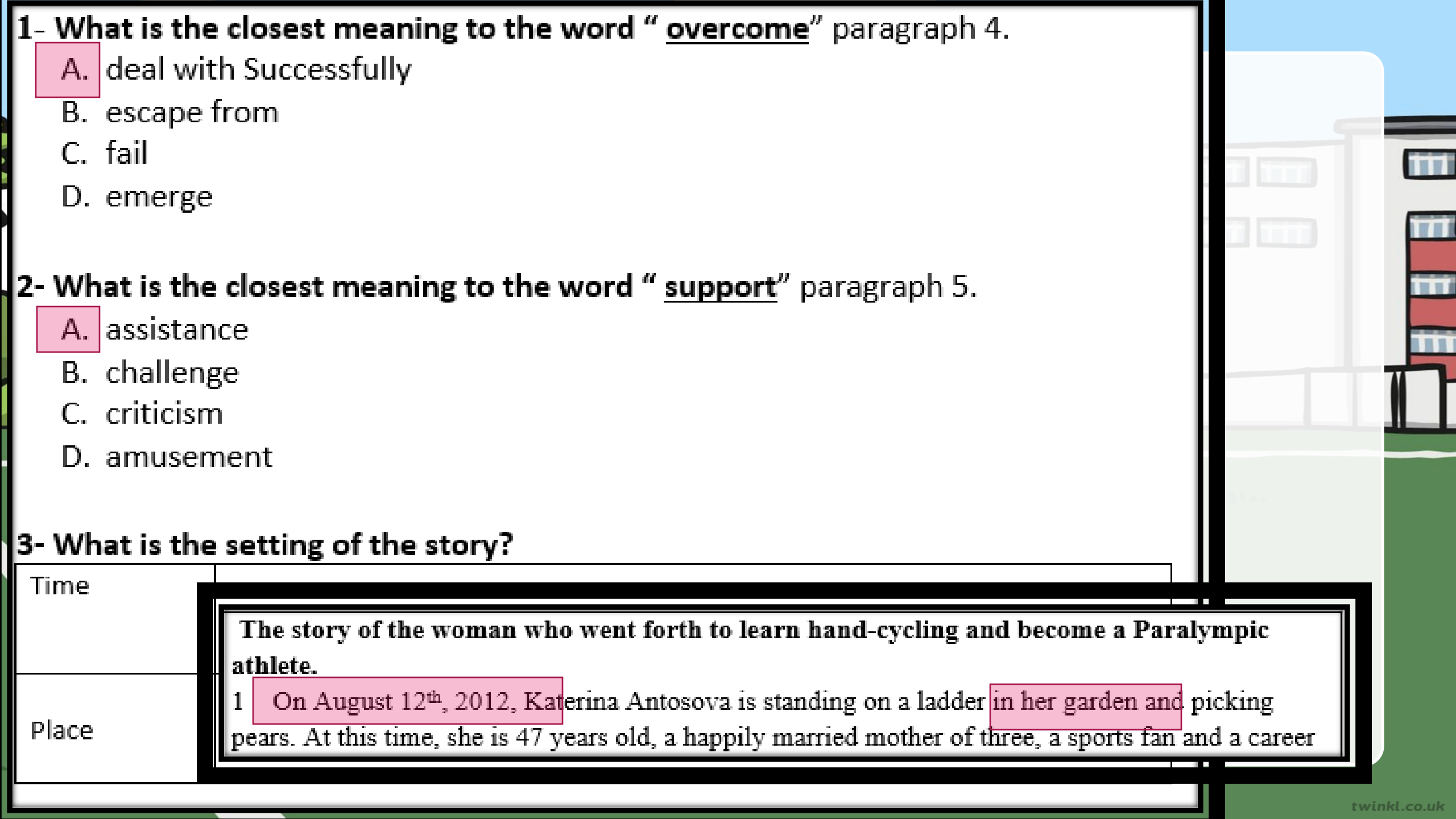
4 Her husband, Tzevan, a mechanical engineer and bicycle-racing enthusiast, encouraged her to buy her first used hand bike after she had left hospital. "I thought it would be nice to have her riding next to me in order to help her overcome her worrying condition ", says Tzevan , "Allowing he to outpace me after such a short period of time was not the plan. But then she also surpassed the other 29 hand bikers in the Czech Republic- all of them men, mind you."

5 Questions such as 'Why did this happen to me?' Was it a punishment? A coincidence? Fate? 'never crossed her mind. "She has always been as unshakeable as a rock and an amazing optimist", mention Tzevan. "I even think that I appreciate my life even more since my accident", says Katerina. "I have received so much help and support from other people. I would like to give some of that back." That's why she began writing her blog from which her book, Para-diary-A diary of a Wheelchair Athlete, would later result.

6 And where does she get the energy for her sport as well as her dedication to others that are also affected, her family and, last but not least, her job as a controller in a bank, which she took on again six months after her accident? "What gives her the most strength are the people in my life- above all, my husband. He is not only my trainer and coach, my personal engineer and travel companion, but also my biggest motivator and best friend."






