(2) The word telephone is even older than the device. It comes from the ancient Greek words for “far” and “sound.” It first referred to the tin-cans-and-string toys that kids played with. In 1876, however, the word’s meaning changed. That was the year that Alexander Graham Bell was allowed for his new invention “telephone”, one that allowed people not anywhere near each other to have spoken conversations. All sorts of things have been added to phones over the years, but their basic design has changed very little.

(3) The first telephones were large, and each was powered by its own battery. Battery power couldn’t carry voices very far, however. That problem was solved in the 1890s, when telephone networks began using outside power sources.
