General Remarks

The test must be built on the test specifications

> The test should address the standards mentioned in the modules covered in the mid of 1st semester overviews.

Grades: 7,8, & 9 = modules (1-2)

- > Question types allowed are SRs (selected response) and CRs (constructed response.)
- ➤ A balance of DOK levels must be maintained throughout the test.
- ➤ The test map is replaced with the new "Teacher's Copy TC" which includes standards, DOK and the model answers. Make sure not to add the standards and the DOK to the "Student's Copy SC".
- Language Functions, Vocabulary & Grammar items should simulate the items of the textbooks.

Listening Section:

- Students should listen to the audio TWICE.
- > The audio must be around 2-3 minutes long.
- The listening audio must be clear with a moderate pace.
- > Students should be given time (two to three minutes) to read the items before they start listening. After the second listening, students should be given time (two minutes) to finalize their answers.

Reading Section:

- > Don't penalize the student's response in the reading **CR** items section for any of the writing mechanics (structure, spelling or punctuation).
- > CR items in the reading section should use only the following Wh-question words (when-where-what-who-how-why) and should ask for information stated (DOK 1) or indicated (DOK 2) in the text.
- CR answers <u>SHOULD</u> be phrases <u>OR</u> sentences <u>NOT ONLY</u> single words or dates.
- > CR answers **SHOULD** address **ONLY ONE** piece of information to be given a zero OR one. **(NO HALVES)**
- > The word count of the text must be strictly as follows: G.7 (100-150) G.8 (150-200) G.9 (200-250)

Speaking Section:

> The oral (speaking assessment) must be assessed according to the rubric provided.

Writing Section

- > Students must be given 2 writing prompts, from which they are to choose only one.
- > Students **SHOULD** organize their responses in separate paragraphs.
- Prompts must not be identical to the ones in the resources, though they must be of the same type.
- > Grading of writing response must be based on the writing rubrics provided.

Test Style:

- > The font-size must be Calibri 14.
- ➤ Closely follow the test template issued by the English Supervision Department Office for the purpose.
- Leave enough space between the items. (4 to 5 items on each page)
- > The SR items should have 4 choices, placed vertically.
- > The score for each section should be placed in the student's test paper.
- ➤ Copying and pasting from the course book into the test is **Not** Acceptable.
- > If the choices are single words with acute difference in length, they are organized lengthwise. If not; alphabetically.
