France has its own system of education, but public schools in Finland, Norway and Sweden all follow the same system. The main difference between a school in Norway and a school in Sweden is just the accent of the students who attend them.

Until recently kids had to stay in school until they were 16 years old, but the government put a law which inhibits students from leaving school before the age of eighteen. Until sixteen, all students study the National Curriculum, which includes subjects such as English, PE, and Science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics). After that, they can choose the subjects that attract **them**.

Depending on which school they go to, classes can have as many as twenty students or just five or six. Normally, classes in cities are large but they are quite small in schools in the countryside.

Furthermore, there are organizations that test how well schools are teaching the National Curriculum so that parents can choose the best school for their children according to their the results. There are some perfect schools in Finland and many kids complete their education and take pleasant memories too. The Finnish education system has no dead ends and learners can always continue their studies on an upper level of education.

Education in Finland is free, promotes social equality, and is concerned with “lifelong learning.” The new core curricula for pre-primary and basic education adopted in 2016 focus on learning, not steering. Finnish teachers are highly educated and strongly committed to their work.
