These countries are India, Nepal, Bhutan, China and Pakistan. Most of the world's highest mountains, including Mountain Everest, are part of the Himalayas. Some of the big rivers rise in the Himalayas such as the Ganges river and the Indus river.

Extreme weather conditions, high altitudes and the rocky ground make life very difficult for people who live in Himalayas.
